

PROGRAMS OF YUN HOUSE Berlin

Yun House is a cultural space where the composer Isang Yun's spirit of contemporary classical music, transcultural and intergenerational dialogues, and Korea's peaceful reunification, to name but a few, is revived by the following programs:

1. Scholarship Program: Long-term scholarship holders seeking at least one Master's degree may stay for six months, one year, and more. On the other hand, short-term fellows can stay for three months until the completion of their respective studies or projects. All scholarship holders are free to participate in the organization of home concerts and other events.
2. House Concerts: The KEB Hana Hall [the former swimming pool of the house in the basement, later called the "Hall"] will be the cradle of new contemporary music and a place where Isang Yun's work and spirit come to life through various convergent programs be awakened.
3. Series of Academic Seminars: We will offer a series of seminars with leading scholars in the humanities, arts and social sciences relevant to Isang Yun's contribution to music and the social movement, always seeking new ideas and methods for peacebuilding and transcultural education dialogues. Social and artistic organizations are also welcome to lead their discussions in the Yun House.
4. Artistic Performances and Exhibitions: In addition to music, the Yun House will invite to exhibitions and various experimental forms of artistic performances that inspire global peace, justice and reconciliation.
